Requirements for drawing up abstracts of the report:

The volume of theses - 1-3 pages of A4 format, text editor - Microsoft Word, book orientation, all margins - 20 mm; font - Times New Roman, point - 12, line spacing - 1.0, paragraph - 1 cm.

Formula editor - MS Equation. Drawings must be grouped.

The first line is the surname and initials of the author or authors (bold font, right-aligned).

The second (for students) - surname, initials, academic degree, academic title of the supervisor (bold italic font, right-aligned).

The third is the name of the institution of higher education (italics, right-aligned).

Across the line is the title of the report (in capital letters, bold font, centered).

Across the line is the text of the abstracts of the report, alignment is width-wise.

At the end, across the line - a list of used sources (according to National Standards of Ukraine 8302:2015).

Authors and supervisors are responsible for the content and design of abstracts.

The materials must be carefully checked according to the rules of spelling and orthography, drawings - grouped. Scanned figures and tables are not allowed. References to used sources are mandatory. References in the text are made out in square brackets, i.e. [2, p. 56], where the first number means the serial number in the list of used sources, the second - the page number.
